
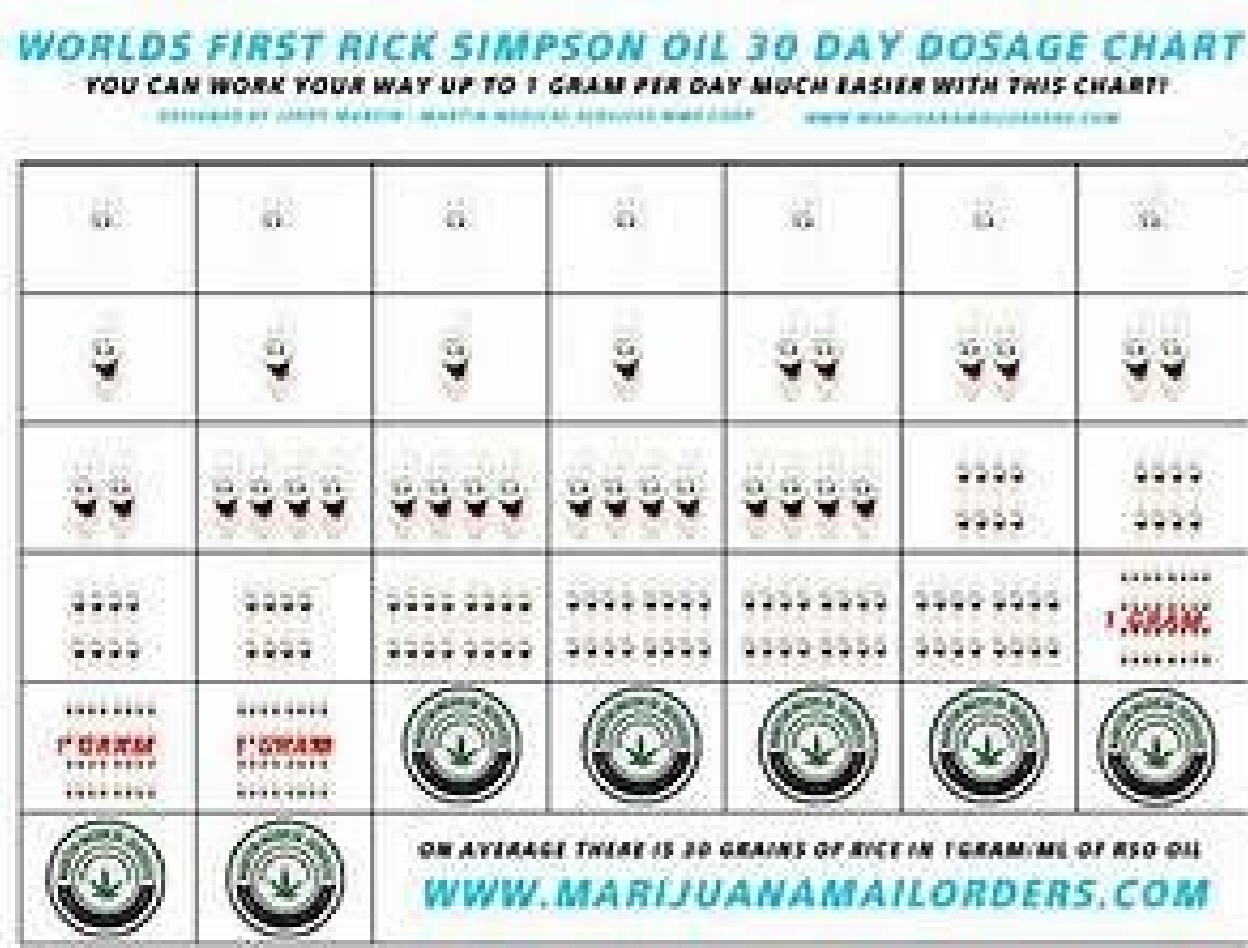

APA (7th edition) guidelines require that running heads be a maximum of 50 characters (spaces count as characters). The "Running head:" label used in the APA sixth edition is no longer used. Place the page number in this same header, but align right, beginning with page number 1 on the title page. This header should be 1 inch from the top. The name of the author(s). The institutional affiliation. An author note, optional (professional papers only). A student paper should also include course information. Note: APA 7 provides slightly different directions for formatting the title pages of professional papers (e.g., those intended for scholarly publication) and student papers (e.g., those turned in for credit in a high school or college course). In the 7th edition, APA increased the flexibility regarding font options: which now include Calibri 11, Arial 11, Lucida Sans Unicode 10, Times New Roman 12, or Georgia 11. All words should be centered, and capitalize the first letter of important words. Running Head: In the 7th edition of the APA style manual, running heads are only required for professional papers that are being submitted for publication (student papers do not require a running head, but still need a page number). Your title page should contain a running head that is flush left at the top of the page and a page number that is flush right at the top of the page. Place the running head in the page's header: The running head is the abbreviated title of the paper (IN UPPERCASE LETTERS) aligned left on the page header of all pages, including the title page. There is no need to put anything other than your name on this line, and it should be as follows: The author's full name, including their middle initial. Placed under the title: Do not include titles or degrees after the name. Under the author byline should be the institutional affiliation where the author conducted the research for the APA style paper. For reference on the proper structure, the full guidelines are in the APA Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association. The APA Publication will have the following two items on every page, beginning with the title page: Think of this as your abbreviated title. This page header's purpose is twofold: identification - identifying the page for the reader in case of page separation. Anonymity - keeping the author nameless during the review process if submitting the paper for publication. Running Head Formatting: Typed in all capital letters. Placed in the header, flush left. Prefix it with the words "Running head:" (remember the colon) on the cover page only. No more than 50 characters long, including spaces. Each of the pages of your APA style paper will have a page number following the below rules. Placement: top right corner in header of the page with the running head. Numbering: begin with 1 on the title page. Justification: right justified. According to the Purdue Online Writing Lab, your APA essay title page should contain three major sections.
